## **TRAVELLING BY CAR**

## **TRAVELLING BY BUS**

**Look out for Bob Thorne, seated by a window, in the bus station café**

**The Transpeak**, arriving 11.20 am at Derby bus station: Buxton (railway station) 9.37 am (market place) 9.40 am: Bakewell (Matlock Street) 10.10 am: Matlock (Bakewell Rd Co-op) 10.35 am: Belper (Trent Barton bus garage) 11.00 am.

**The Ilkeston Flyer** (running every 20 minutes) picks up at: Beauvale Road, Bridge Street, Granby Street, Wharncliffe Road, Godfrey Drive and the Cat & Fiddle: maximum journey time from Beauvale Road 40 minutes. Be at Derby bus station by 11.20 am.

**From Dronfield**: catch the 9.03 am Stage Coach Chesterfield bus (43) on Gosforth Lane then the Red Arrow from Chesterfield, as noted below. Other option – see “by rail” below.

**The Red Arrow**: arriving 10.53 am at Derby bus station: Chesterfield (New Beetwell Street B14) 9.50 am: Alfreton (Hall Street bus station) 10.18 am: Ripley High Street (Qube) 10.33 am.

**The Swift**, from Ashbourne bus station at 10.25 am, arriving Derby bus station 11.05 am.

**The Zoom, from Long Eaton**, arriving 11.10 am at Derby bus station: Long Eaton Green 10.42 am: Derby Road / Wilsthorpe Road 10.46 am: Breaston Church 10.49 am: Draycott Square 10.53 am: Borrowash (Victoria Avenue) 10.57 am.

## **TRAVELLING BY RAIL**

**Hope 9.39 am / Hathersage 9.46 am** to Sheffield. Transfer to the 10.24 am (Reading) train, arriving at Derby railway station at 10.51 am.

**Dronfield 10.15 am to Chesterfield**. Transfer to the 10.41 am (London St Pancras) train arriving at Derby railway station at 11.00 am.

**Derbyshire Wayfarer** (day rover) tickets can be really good value, especially for the “over 60's”. Purchase in advance from Bakewell Tourist Information Centre / Newbury's, Chesterfield Road, Dronfield.

**There are frequent buses from Derby railway station (just a few minutes journey) to the bus station where you can meet up with Bob Thorne.**

**NOTE:** Bus & Rail time tables occasionally change. Please check before travelling.
